



2023 Household Electricity Credit

On 11 May 2023, the [State Government announced](#) that eligible Western Australian households will receive a Household Electricity Credit to ease cost of living pressures. For some households, the payment includes an amount provided by the Commonwealth Government under the [National Energy Bill Relief Fund](#).

Households billed directly by Synergy or Horizon Power received the credit in two instalments - in July and December.

Households charged for their electricity use by third party providers, such as residents on embedded networks or submetering arrangements in certain retirement villages, can apply for a payment from RevenueWA if they incurred electricity charges at 9 May 2023.

The application closing date has been extended to 31 March 2024. We can't accept late applications.

Eligible households must apply by 31 March 2024 if they have not already received a payment from RevenueWA or lodged an application for this year's credit.
